

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The program aims to address this issue by providing creative and simplified approaches to help stakeholders understand and apply scientific research methods. To achieve this aim, the specific objectives of this workshop are to:

- Understand research methods and foster a research culture in technical institutions/engineering universities of the OIC member states.
- Enhance personal knowledge of research and developrelevant research proposals for institutional development in the OIC member states.
- Strengthen institutional capacity by improving the research and development component of technical institutions/engineering universities of the OIC member states.

- 1. Identifying research problems and formulating objectives, questions, and hypothesis.
- 2. Writing research proposals.
- 3. Developing research instruments.
- 4. Use of referencing software.
- 5. Writing research report.
- 6. Ethics in scientific research.
